

Call for Applications: Curriculum Chair The Canadian Child Health Clinician Scientist Program

The Canadian Child Health Clinician Scientist Program (CCHCSP) invites applications from qualified clinician scientists for the position of Curriculum Chair. The Curriculum Chair plays a critical role in training the next generation of child health clinician scientists in Canada.

The CCHCSP is a transdisciplinary training program for the next generation of clinician scientists in child and youth health research. The program provides support for highly qualified child health clinician candidates to develop their requisite knowledge and skills for a career as an independent scientist in child health research. Trainees engage in research training and a core curriculum based in one of the seventeen CCHCSP partner Child Health Research Training Centres. The successful candidate will be a clinician scientist in one of the clinical disciplines currently supported by the CCSCHP and will hold an academic appointment at one of the CCHCSP partner Child Health Research Training Centres. The candidate will have an established record of academic leadership, a nationally recognized program of grant-funded research in child health, and a commitment to training child health researchers. Expertise in Clinician Education or Educational Research is an asset but not required.

The responsibilities of the Curriculum Chair involve working collaboratively with the Curriculum Committee, CCHCSP Director and Program Manager to lead and develop novel tools for the curriculum while ensuring effective up-to-date curriculum content within the existing infrastructure. JOB DESCRIPTION Curriculum Chair, CCHCSP

As the Curriculum Chair for the Canadian Child Health Clinician Scientist Program you will be responsible for the operation and advancement of the CCHCSP Core Curriculum. You will work directly with the CCHCSP Director, Program Manager and Curriculum Committee, to ensure effective up-to-date content and tools within the existing infrastructure and potential for novel tools and advancement. This includes:

- Chairing of the Curriculum Committee that meets monthly, to oversee all modules, webinars, online tools, and social media initiatives
- Participate and oversee the organization of the Annual Symposium. This includes active participation
 in monthly teleconferences from September to June with the Symposium Co-Chairs, the CCHCSP
 Director and Program Manager.
- Communicate and meet with Centre Leaders bi-annually, strengthening the engagement at each centre and resolving any centre based concerns as needed.
- Present twice at the Annual Symposium for the Centre Leader Curriculum Update and the Board meeting which includes all Centre Leaders and CCHCSP Committee members.
