
RECRUITMENT UPDATE: MAGIC

SUBJECTS WANTED: SUB-STUDIES CURRENTLY RECRUITING

Did you know that the IMAGINE Network is supporting a number of research sub-studies in sites across Canada? Here are a few of our sub-studies who are currently recruiting:

Our **Stress Reduction in IBD** study uses an online stress reduction program to help people with IBD identify and manage stress.

The **Patient Preferences in IBD Treatments** study is working to help us understand what is important to people with IBD when choosing between treatments. **Please note this study is only open to residents of Alberta or Manitoba who are enrolled in the MAGIC main cohort study.*



The **PET Imaging** study in Toronto will be brain scanning patients with IBD who are also clinically depressed to better understand how the two relate to each other.


